Measles

You may be aware of a case of measles that has been reported in our area. This makes it more likely that we will have a case at school. If a case of an infectious disease (e.g. measles / mumps) is reported, students who are not vaccinated or if we do not have evidence of 2 x MMR vaccines, will be required to stay away from school for 14 days after the last reported case. If there are multiple cases, this may be a significant length. If you have not given us evidence of 2 MMR vaccines please do so as soon as possible.


