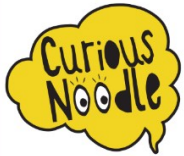

The petition requests the creation of a non-political national cancer agency to address NZs cancer survival rates (which are lower than Australia and the UK) and have responsibility for prevention, early detection, treatment and survivorship. The agency would set clear targets which the DHBs and government are accountable for, and report outcomes to the public.
